LED SURFACE DISK LIGHT INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS


IMPORTANT:

- This device is not intend for use with emergency exits or not for emergency lighting.



INSTALLATION ONTO OUTLET BOX

1. Attach mounting plate to the outlet box by fastening supplied 1½" outlet box screws through mounting plate keyholes.(Fig.1)



2. Align spring clips on the disk light to hinge on the mounting plate. Tuck all wires into the outlet box and push up to lock fixture in place (Fig. 2)



3. Make sure the disk Light is flush to the ceiling. (Fig. 3)

ELECTRICAL CONNECTION

- 1. Provide electrical service according to the "National Electrical Code" or your local electrical code to the outlet box.
- 2. Connect supply wires to fixture wires and insulate with proper size wire nuts (Fig. 1).
 - a.) Connect incoming ground wire (green or bare) to fixture ground wire (green or bare).
 - Connect incoming common (white) wire to fixture common (white).
 - Connect incoming hot (typically black) wire to fixture black

NOTE: For wet locations, Fill the gap between the luminaire and the ceiling with waterproof glue after installation completed (Fig. 3).
